calm

Someone who is <u>brave</u> is willing to do things they are scared to do, even though they are afraid.

terrified

When someone is <u>terrified</u>, they feel very scared.

destined

Something that is <u>destined</u> to happen will happen no matter what because there is nothing you can

hope

Hope is a feeling that you want something to happen so much that you keep waiting for it.

agree

When people <u>agree</u>, they have the same idea or think in the same way.

advice

When someone gives you advice, they tell you how you could do a better job.

pout

When you <u>pout</u>, you push out your lip to show that you're mad or sad.

allowed

When someone is <u>allowed</u> to do something, it is alright for them to do it, and they will not get in

forgive

When you <u>forgive</u> someone who has done something wrong, you stop being angry with them and tell them it is okay.

report

spicy

When something is <u>spicy</u>, it has a very strong taste and smell, and may even cause a burning feeling in your mouth.

mild

When something is <u>mild</u>, it does not have a very strong taste or smell.

key

When something is <u>key</u>, it's a very important thing.

shelter

When you take <u>shelter</u> in a place, you go and stay there to keep yourself safe.

sturdy

When something is <u>sturdy</u>, it is strong and not easily knocked down or broken.

kind

When you are <u>kind</u>, you are gentle, caring, and helpful to others.

expect

When you <u>expect</u> something to happen, you think and believe it will happen.

gather

When you <u>gather</u> things, you get and put them all together.

gloomy

When a place is <u>gloomy</u>, it is dark, and you can't see very well.

stumble

When you <u>stumble</u>, you trip over something and almost fall.

through

When you go through something, you go right into it, so it is also around you.

under

When you are <u>under</u> something, you are below it.

over

When you go <u>over</u> something, you go above or on top of it to get to the other side.

run smoothly

When things <u>run smoothly</u>, they go as planned.

borrow

When you <u>borrow</u> something, you take and use it for a little while, and then give it back.

attention

When you give someone your <u>attention</u>, you look at them and listen to what they are saying.

respect

When you show <u>respect</u> for someone, you do nice things that don't bother or hurt them.

manners

When you have good manners, you do polite or nice things.

bilingual

When you are <u>bilingual</u>, you can speak two languages very well.

unique

When someone or something is <u>unique</u>, it is special and one of a kind.

boring

When something is <u>boring</u> to you, you think it's dull and not interesting.

subject

A <u>subject</u> is something you learn more about in a class, like art, math, music, and English.

mismatch

When things <u>mismatch</u>, they don't look good or work well together.

match

When things <u>match</u>, they look good and work well together.

soak

protest

When you <u>protest</u>, you tell and show whoever will listen that you don't agree with something.

favor

When you do someone a <u>favor</u>, you do something for them even though you don't have to.

extinct

When an animal or plant is <u>extinct</u>, there is no longer any living animal or plant of its kind anywhere anymore.

cut-off

A <u>cut-off</u> is the last place two roads are joined or touch.

tussle

When you <u>tussle</u>, you fight in a friendly way.

steep

When something is <u>steep</u>, it's almost straight up and down.

on schedule

When something is <u>on</u> <u>schedule</u>, it happens on time.

decide

When you <u>decide</u> something, you choose one thing over another.
